



# **VIOLAE**

#### MONFERRATO ROSSO D.O.C.

This wine comes from a skillful blend of Barbera and Syrah grapes, from the company's youngest vineyards. The grapes are very fresh and fruity, bringing out the full potential and versatility of the their identity.

Intense red colour with crimson-purple highlights; very pronounced notes of red fruits, sour cherry, and nutmeg, light but not intrusive acidity.

Serve at 17°-18°C.

## Soil / Vineyard

Calcareous clay with silty marls and alkaline pH with considerable water retention.

The average age of the vines is 10 years, facing west, southwest.

#### Vinification / Ageing

Crushing-destemming with floating-cap fermentation and frequent pumping over and aeration. Duration of the fermentation: about 8 days. 30% ageing in small second- or third fill barrels: barriques and tonneaux.

# Colours / Highlights

Intense red.

#### Fragrance

Good complexity and finesse, with notes of earthiness, spices and minerals.

#### Palate

Velvet-smooth, with an intense presence of red fruits (cherry in particular), clean and soft.
